

Requirement to post a Cat on South Bay Cats Petfinder or Adopt-a-Pet pages.

- Cats Name
- Breed or markings (Siamese, Tabby)- we assume mixed breed
- Color/colors (Orange, Black and White)
- Coat length (Short hair, Medium hair, Long hair)
- Gender
- Size when grown (small, medium, large, x-large)-Guess if not known
- Age (Kitten <6mo, Young < 1 Yr, Adult <8 Yrs, Senior >8 Yrs)
- Is the animal good/bad/don't know with other Cats?
- Is the animal good/bad/don't know with Dogs?
- Is the animal good/bad/don't know with young Children?
- We assume the cat is spayed or neutered, litter box trained and up to date on shots.
- Birth date if know. OR born in May, or born early 2012, or 3 to 5 years old etc.
- Is the animal special needs, declawed , FIV positive etc..
- Photos, we need at least one digital photo of the animal.
- You need to write something about the animal.

You can give me the information in the format above or you can write about the cat.

As an example: Martin a beautiful long hair, brown tabby, Maine coon mix, who is a big boy, is friendly with every one he meets. He likes other cats and our kids but he is not so hot on dogs. He was born in mid 2009 and is very healthy with all his shots up to date. He is neutered with excellent litter box manners. If you think you would like a warm purring love bug in your lap while watching TV this is your cat.
